## Facebook live Bible Study Session 19

An enormous welcome to tonight's bible study. As I mentioned last time we will not spend anytime at all going into Ministry updates as there is a Newsletter out for this and I suggest that you sign up for it if you have not already done so.

To begin our session we now open up with prayer:

Tonight's prayer passages focus are based on Psalm 63 v 1 – 11 and psalm 119 v 38-50

Psalm 63

O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.

So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.

Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.

So I will bless you as long as I live; in your names I will lift up my hands.

My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips,

When I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night;

For you have been my help, and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy.

My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.

But those who seek to destroy my life shall go down into the depths of the earth;

They shall be given over to the power of the sword; they shall be a portion for jackals.

But the king shall rejoice in God; all who swear by him shall exult, for the mouths of liars will be stopped.

Psalm 119 v38-50

Confirm to your servant your promise, that you may be feared.

Turn away the reproach that I dread, for your rules are good.

Behold, I long for your precepts;

In your righteousness give me life!

Let your steadfast love come to me, O Lord your salvation according to your promise;

Then shall I have an answer for him who taunts me, for I trust in your word.

Now for tonight's bible study

Last month we looked at the key word beginning.

Tonight the second key word we will attempt to interpret this evening is the word Created This word is common to both Genesis Chapter 1 and John Chapter 1 and appears to have some significance exactly what significance we shall examine. We have already established that the word created was given the following definition.

Created :- `bring into existence invest (someone) with a title of nobility, make a fuss; complain the creation: creating of the universe, especially when regarded as an act of God

We note that the word made occurs in verse 3, 10, 14, 18 and 23

From the use of the word created and made we can see that there is a subtle difference although the words are synonyms. That difference is that the word created implies ownership/responsibility whereas the word made is restricted to the process of forming something.
