## ATMOSPHERE EMPHATIC STATEMENTS

### Genesis Chapter 1

We have already established that the author is writing an inventory of all that God said and did in the beginning and how correct everything was and God's instructions. Atmosphere of warning and expectation. Implication of an attitude of thanksgiving and gratitude mixed with a bit of caution.

### Genesis Chapter 1

Firstly, let us identify what we mean by emphatic statements key words to look for are truly, verily, behold, indeed, finally, especially, last of all, I tell you.

#### Emphatic statements

V29 .....Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the earth and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for food.

V30And to every beast of the earth and to every bird of the heavens and to everything that creeps on the earth, everything that has the breath of life, I have given every green plant for food." And it was so.

V31And God saw everything that he made and behold, it was very good.....

### John Chapter 1

The overall mood of this narrative is a little tricky to decipher Joy mixed up with a bit of relief, and humility .

#### Emphatic Statements.

V29.....,"Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

V36....Behold the Lamb of God

V47....Behold, an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!

V49....king of Israel!

V51....truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the son of Man.

Both Genesis Chapter 1 and John Chapter 1 are Narratives we have established this earlier on in our studies.

## GENERAL STRUCTURE

### Genesis Chapter 1

V1-31 Creation of the World in six days

- V1-2 God created the Heaven and the Earth
- V3-5 God separated Light from the Dark called it Day and Night
- V6-8 God created the Expanse to separate the waters
- V9-10 God created the dry land and the seas
- V11-13 God created plants and trees.
- V14-19 God created light in the expanse and defined them greater and lesser light.
- V20-23 God created the Sea creatures and the birds of the air.
- V24-28 God created the beasts of the earth and livestock and Man whom he gave dominion over everything.
- V29-31 God summarises all that he has provided for food for the living things.

### John chapter 1

V1-18 The Genealogy of the word becoming Flesh

V19-28 The Testimony of John the Baptist

V29-34 John confirms Jesus's identity to his disciples

V35-42 Jesus first disciples are called.

V43-51 Jesus Calls Phillip and Nathanael.
